#### **Maths**





It is proven that by reviewing what you've learnt at regular intervals, you can reduce how much you forget to just 10%


Review your work 4 times within a month and you'll remember nearly 100%




# **HOW TO REVIEW**

#### Vary your activities to maximise your memory's power.

<b>Mind Mapping</b> Watch GCSEPod and write down all the key words. Now from memory, fill in as much information as you can remember.	<b>Review Maps</b> Cover your mind map and see how much you can remember. Highlight the information you couldn't remember and revise it.	Memory Cards With a friend, create your own question cards with answers on the reverse and then test each other's knowledge.	<b>Past Papers</b> Watch GCSEPod again and practice past paper questions.
